

Bioblitz!

May 10-11, 2019

In this 24 hour extravaganza, scientists and citizen scientists took a census of the flora and fauna of Riverside's natural areas along the Des Plaines River. Results were posted on iNaturalist.org for global review. The event was sponsored by the Frederick Law Olmsted Society and Landscape Advisory Commission with generous funding from Openlands.

There were 323 observations, 147 species verified, 56 identifiers and 17 observers. The most observations were American Bladdernut (8 observations) and White-tailed Deer (6 observations). [All of the results are on the iNaturalist website.](#)
